




You will need a piece of cotton and a tie cord of your choice

Use my template for a small gift bag version, or make your own.

Simply make a rectangle the size you would like your bag to be and add 2 cm seam allowance on the sides and base and 3 cm seam allowance on the top edge.



Step 1

For the first side seam, take a 2 cm seam allowance and sew 3 cm down, back tack and then leave a gap of 1.5 cm, this is for the tie cord - now continue to sew the rest of the seam.





From the wrong side press the seam allowance in half and tuck under. The top stitch in place, this makes a strong and neat seam.

This is how it looks from the right side



Step 2

To create the other side seam we will make a French seam. First take 1 cm seam allowance on the right side of the fabric, trim down this edge by half to neaten. The turn the bag to the wrong side and take 1 cm seam allowance, this captures the raw edge in the seam.



Sew side seam from the right side trim down by half





The base of the bag can also be finished with a french seam



Turn the bag to the right side





Turn to the wrong side and sew again taking 1 cm seam allowance

Step 4 - the top of the bag



Fold the top hem down by 1.5 cm and then down again - press.



The 1.5 cm gap will be perfectly aligned on the right side



Thread through the tie cord
